Make turn-ons and turn-offs according to work orders to connect or disconnect service.

May operate auxiliary equipment such as purification or treatment system.

Required knowledge, skills and abilities:

Requirements include:

- Two years' experience in pipefitting or general maintenance mechanic with some pipefitting Ability to work effectively with Company personnel, regulatory agencies, and the public in a cooperative and professional manner.
- Ability to operate heavy equipment and welding experience.
- Understanding of water production and distribution methods and systems.
- Mechanical aptitude: use of hand tools and understanding of basic mechanics.
- Must be able to use, or learn to use, the handheld meter reading device and related equipment.

- Must have a Grade 1 ADEQ certification in Water Distribution.
